St Magnus International Festival is a beacon amidst the summer arts festivals in Scotland. Now in its 49th year, it shines a light on the Orkney Islands and attracts visitors from around the globe as well as a large local audience. The festival is at the heart of the community and brings the local heritage, history, landscape and seascape to bear on an annual programme of 40-50 events. With a focus on music, the Festival is multi-arts and, in any year, can have a mix of concerts, cabaret, theatre, literary events, opera, ballet and site specific installations. The programme is world class and brings the best of the new talent as well as the internationally renowned to its stages. From Symphony Orchestras to ballet productions, exhibitions to outdoor extravaganzas, the St Magnus Internaitonal Festival is a truly unique midsummer celebration.





The festival is regularly featured in news and features within both radio and tv broadcast media and the reach of the event through Social Media channels is significant. Over the last years the festival has featured in print media and garnered 5-star reviews for its programming and certain events. Each year is a unique offering and the Festival's Director is renowned for bringing new ideas to the fore and exploiting the place, Orkney, where they take place.
